RESTAURANT & PUB

The Kenton Hotel was built in 1909 by Swift Meat Packing Co. as the landmark of their company town "Kenton". It was there the cattle buyers from the Midwest would meet with ranchers from eastern Oregon to buy and sell stock. The hotel slowly deteriorated in the 70's and 80's until it was closed. A Demolition Order was Issued in 1990, but the building was saved from a wrecking ball by John Condon and Gratziano Della Gasperina. A three year renovation became the Historic Kenton Apartments.
